

## *P*esach Information FYI

**Water** - Any fresh, bottled, spring or distilled water that is unflavored may be used (including those with fluoride or minerals).

**Soy milk** contains *kitniyos* and possibly *chometz* and, under normal circumstances, may not be consumed on *Pesach*. The following soy milk products are *chometz*-free and may be consumed by someone who is allowed to eat *kitniyos* (e.g. one who is ill). It is recommended that those who require these products ideally purchase them before *Pesach*:

**Soy Dream Original Soy Milk Unenriched (OU)**  
[No extra vitamins added]

**Vitasoy (San Sui) Original Natural Soymilk (OU)**  
[Generally available in stores that sell Chinese food]

**ZenSoy Refrigerated Half Gallon (OU)**  
Organic Vanilla, Organic Plain  
Organic Chocolate

**Almond Breeze Almond Soy Milk (OU)**  
Unflavored

**LACTAID caplets** may contain *chometz* and may not be used on *Pesach*. Lactaid Milk may be used on *Pesach* if purchased before *Pesach*. This product is not *Cholov Yisroel*.

**Kosher for Pesach Prepared Foods** that are sealed and labeled with the Star-K Passover symbol will be made available through **Catering by Weiss, Simchas & Brachas** and **Seven Mile Market**.

The following **local eating establishments** will offer a Kosher for *Pesach* menu and will be open during *Chol Hamoed Pesach*:

**Important: No one** should refrain from taking any required medication, even if it contains *chometz*, without first consulting his/her physician and *Rav*. Note: All medications for a heart condition, diabetes, abnormal blood pressure, stroke, kidney disease, lung disease, depression, epilepsy, the immune system (transplant anti-rejection), and cancer treatment (including precautionary) may be taken on *Pesach*. Furthermore, all prescription medication taken on a regular basis for chronic conditions should only be changed with the consultation of your physician (if you can not reach your physician, you should continue to take your regular prescription and not change). Some examples of such chronic conditions include the following: any psychiatric condition, prostate condition, Crohn's Disease, colitis, high cholesterol, Parkinson's Disease, anemia, Multiple Sclerosis, thyroid condition, and asthma.
