After Pesach, Chometz in Jewish owned stores that did not sell their chometz properly may not be purchased until the stock that was in the store on Pesach is no longer being sold. Depending on the store this can be anywhere from a week to a month. The local Rav or Kashrus Agency should be consulted for exact dates and locations where Chometz She'avar Alav HaPesach is an issue. Not all products fall into this category. The following chart offers guidelines as to which products are Chometz She'avar Alav HaPesach.

May NOT be Purchased

Alcoholic Beverages- Liquor, Whiskey etc.
Beer
Bread
Cake
Cereal with ingredient of wheat, oats, or barley
Chometz Nokshe (e.g., chometz glue)
Cookies
Malt flavoring (as flavoring)
Maltose (as flavoring)
Oatmeal
Pasta
Pretzels
Rolled Oats
Soy Sauce (containing wheat)
Wheat Germ
Wheat Gluten or Wheat Protein (ingredient)

May be Purchased

Barley (if pearly, raw, and packaged)
Condiments containing vinegar (Ketchup, Mayonnaise, Mustard, Pickles)
Cosmetics
Detergents
Extracts
Flour
Food Coloring
Kitniyos
Maltodextrin
Mayonnaise
Medicine
Modified Potato Starch
Mustard
Pickles
Vanillin and Ethyl Vanillin
Vinegar (from unknown sources)
Vitamins
Yeast (Baker's)
Yeast Extract
